

# **BRUSH PARK BOWLING CLUB**

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

**Entry to the Brush Park Bowling Club is permitted according to the requirements of the Registered Clubs Act 1976, a copy of which is displayed in the front foyer of the Club premises.**

**In addition, the Club has introduced the following local rules to assist members and their guests, to take advantage of the facilities available for their enjoyment.**

**ENTRY TO THE CLUB** – Members entering the Club are required to produce their membership card as requested by authorised personnel. Visitors to the Club are required to complete an entry form, available at the foyer or bar area, in accordance with the requirements of the licensing laws.

The Club reserves the right to refuse entry to any visitor without explanation. Any member or guest can be refused entry to the Club if it is deemed the person is intoxicated, appears to be nearing or shows signs of intoxication.

**ENTRY FOR MINORS** - Children are not permitted to enter or remain in the designated bar area or the gaming machine area or the Club. Whilst on the Club premises or surrounds, children must be supervised by a parent or other responsible adult.

**CAR PARKING** - The Club car park is for members, their guests and authorised personnel and is available for use only whilst they remain on the Club premises. The Club is not responsible for any damage caused to vehicles whilst in the car park.

**CLUB DRESS** - The minimum standard of wear is smart casual along with a clean and neat appearance. Wearing rubber thong footwear is not permitted in the dining room after 6pm.

**CONDUCT** - In order to ensure the comfort of all patrons, no member or other guest may create undue noise or disturbance, use offensive language, or disrespect the privacy of other members and guests, either on the premises or its surrounds. Members and their guests are requested to leave the Club in a quiet orderly manner respecting our neighbours.

**SMOKING** - Under the NSW Health Act 2000 and the Smoke-Free Environment Regulation 2016, all indoor areas are non-smoking. Smoking is also banned within 4 metres of a seated dining area, within 4 metres of the main entrance to the club, and on the Greens. There is a designated smoking area outside of the club to the right of the club entry or is permitted in other non-designated areas of the grounds.

**RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL** - The club maintains a Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy which can be viewed at the entry foyer.

**RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF GAMING** - The Club maintains a Responsible Gaming Policy which can be viewed at the entry foyer.

**ACCESS TO THE GREENS** – No access is permitted to the Clubs number 2 (middle green on the left of the Rutledge Street entry) or number 3 (far green on the left of the club entry from Rutledge Street) Bowling Greens.

**DESIGNATED PLAY AREA** - Green 1, to the right from the Rutledge Street, entry, is available for social or recreational use by members and their guests. Children using this green for play, must be under the direct supervision of a parent or another responsible adult for the duration of their stay on the club premises or surrounds. Care should be taken that greens 2 & 3 are not accessed by any child, other person or any sporting equipment i.e. balls, etc. in use on green 1. Any sporting or other equipment accidentally intruding on Greens 2 or 3 should be retrieved by an officer of the club.

**GROUP FUNCTIONS** – The Club welcomes group bookings for events such as meetings, conferences, weddings and other parties, barefoot bowls and other casual group functions. At the discretion of the Club, the following conditions may be required:

- Group bookings, with the anticipated number of guests, should be made well in advance by contacting the Bar Supervisor on 9858 1166 and confirming the facilities are available on the required date and whether restaurant facilities will be required.
- Confirmation of the booking should be made 7 days prior to the event with final details of the numbers attending to ensure adequate staffing by the Club and catering by the restaurant if required.
- All meals and other food must be provided by the Club restaurant, Golden Fusion. In the event Golden Fusion is unable to provide some elements of the food required, approval to supplement restaurant meals may be given at the discretion of the Club.
- Entertainment may be arranged at the discretion of the Club with the cost to be met by your function.
- The Club may determine that additional security is required with the cost to be met by your function.
- Payment for beverages etc. can be made using cash, credit card or EPTPOS at the bar. Payment for meals should be made directly to the Golden Fusion restaurant.
